PRE-VISIT INFO

Here are some pre-visit tips for planning and what to expect when you arrive.

Meow Wolf is a sensory experience with the possibility of crowds, dark space, loud noises, lights, projections, and waiting in line. Specialty lighting and other visual effects are used extensively throughout the exhibition. Lighting effects include strobe lights, other pulsating lighting effects, dance club lighting, chaser lights, and more. Planning ahead and contacting us with any concerns will make sure you have a safe and enjoyable experience with us.

Ticketing

We highly recommend you pre-purchase your tickets online in advance for the day and time you plan on visiting as entry is by reserved timeslot. Tickets may be purchased on-site at our on-site ticket window, but immediate entry may not be available depending on availability. Reserve your preferred date and time at **meowwolf.com/visit**. YOUR EXPERIENCE

Arrive at Meow Wolf Denver via RTD at Empower Field at Mile High Station, or you can discover a variety of parking options in the vicinity of our Denver Meow Wolf location, Convergence Station, within the downtown area.

Accessible parking is available at all parking areas, though it's limited. Depending on the specific lot and its current capacity, you may need to allow for a 15-20 minute journey to reach the main entrance. We recommend parking in the main lot by the entrance (1338 1st St, Denver, CO 80204) for easy access. There are 8 designated parking spots available for participants with a valid disability parking permit in our main lot on a first come-first served basis. Find alternative parking, including on NFL game days, at the 5th Street Parking Garage, located at 650 Walnut St, Denver, CO 80204. Electric Vehicle charging stations are available. For the latest information and rates, please visit Auraria Parking. No cash accepted; credit and debit cards only.

No matter how you arrive, we look forward to you visiting.

Proceed to the Main Entrance at **1338 1st St, Denver, CO 80204**.

Have your tickets available on your smartphone, sent via email, printed, or purchase a ticket at our box office.

Enter one of two outdoor queues, depending on your designated time slot and the current time. If you arrive in your current time slot, you will proceed directly to the security queue. If you arrive early, you will be asked to enter a queue to wait for your time slot.

Empty any liquids in the receptacle, a water refill station is located inside at the HELLOFOOD Cafe and near the restrooms in the lobby. If there are other liquids that you must have with you for medical purposes, please contact a staff member prior to entering. Proceed through security. Please let a security guard know if you have metal in your body or need any accommodations.

Screening Area

Before entering our exhibition, we require that all guests with any outside liquids and/or food dispose of these items before security. If someone in your party requires an exception for medical reasons, please let a staff member know prior to entering the queue. Additionally, please see any staff member prior to entering if you need to utilize your stroller as a wheelchair as strollers are not allowed in the exhibition. Feel free to email help@meowwolf.com to ensure a smooth experience.

Once at the security checkpoint, all guests will be required to pass through a metal detector and have their bags checked in compliance with Meow Wolf Code of Conduct and Allowable items. At the checkpoint, security staff members will check all jackets, bags, purses, and other personal items.

After security, you will park your stroller in the stroller parking area prior to entering the queue line. Then, you will proceed through the main doors where your tickets will be scanned.

- Scan your ticket.
- Visit the Information Desk on the first floor for any additional information or questions.
- Coat Check is located on the first floor, to the left of the doors.
- Explore the world of Convergence Station.
- Grab some local food or drinks at the HELLOFOOD Cafe.
- Shop unique Meow Wolf Merchandise.
- Have a safe journey home.

SUMMARY

Once a thriving civilization powered by cosmic Navigators, Eemia was cast into an ice age 1,000 years ago due to a sun's eruption, reducing its once-mighty society to a few wanderers longing for the return of the Navigators to restore light and warmth. Experience a discordant soundscape with surround sound, vibrating bass, and quick light transitions.

NUMINA

SUMMARY

Numina is an organic landscape that is actually a sixth-dimensional sentient plant - the many cells of which are all timelines and universes within. As you navigate the space, which could involve close interactions with others, anticipate shifts from light to dark, illuminated by bright lights and a mix of sounds with a discordant sound-scape with vibrating bass.

Ossuary houses Oss, a memory crystal vital to the Convergence's economy and the Library's multiversal knowledge, but its value has also sparked concerns about corruption and theft, leading to calls for its strict protection.
